

job was set up in one of the Booster Lines and 175,000 hand grenades were refuzed, repacked and shipped overseas.

In connection with 105mm normal maintenance operations conducted on the Load Line, the Depot was required to slit the bags generated from this operation. This operation was initiated in the Bundling Building on approved type copper lined tables, utilizing four girls at each table. All tables were grounded and deluge systems were installed. The resultant prop powder was packed in M2 cans and returned to Radford Arsenal for reblending, along with the empty dulling grain drums.

Operations were also set up in the LCL Building to perform normal maintenance and repack 350,000 M82, 90mm shell. These rounds are wire-brushed, spot-painted, repacked in Condition 1 boxes and put in long-term storage.

The Depot was also faced at this time with storing an over-production of fertilizer. Inasmuch as fertilizer was considered Class 9 after the Texas explosion, all fertilizer which had previously been stored in inert warehouses had to be removed and stored in igloos until sufficient box cars could be obtained to move it to the Port.

The 105mm and 90mm shell which were scheduled for load line operation had to be sorted by vendor and vendor lot. This requirement necessitated considerable analysis and was estimated at a cost of nearly 20¢ per round.

During all this time in 1948 there were tremendous "Blitz" shipments to Europe, many times requiring two twelve-hour shifts. These shipments consisted of all types of ammunition, and sometimes as high

and women were employed for the work.

In 1949 a portable shot-blasting machine was installed in one of the covered X pads, and many thousands of 500 and 1,000 pound bomb fins were cleaned, repaired and shipped.

In 1950 instructions were received that normal maintenance was required on all heavy and light mortar shell. This included changing the fuzes, increments, primers and ignition cartridge. Work was started in the latter part of 1950 in one of the Booster Lines, with Depot crews used exclusively. All the light mortar were reconditioned in this manner; however, before a project could be started with heavy mortars the contractor had taken over the plant and transferred that operation to the Load Lines.

Bomb renovation was started in 1949, utilizing Load Line IV with Depot crews. Many thousands of bombs were wire brushed, repainted, restenciled and sent to the Depot for inside long-term storage.

Throughout the years of 1946 to 1950 there were many normal maintenance and minor modification operations accomplished in the Depot, including all calibers of fixed and semi-fixed ammunition.
