Subject: UST Soil Removal

Dear Mr. Lyles:

Ravenna Army Ammunition Plant is currently in the process of permanently removing underground storage tanks in accordance with BUSTR permit number 8476, issued 03/30/93. Upon removing a 1,000 gallon 11' x 4' number 2 fuel oil tank a small area of contamination was discovered in the excavation pit. No free product was found, and the tank itself did not appear to be leaking.

Pursuant to OAC 1301:7-9-12 (I)(1)(d), we are requesting your approval to continue excavation of soils in the tank cavity to no more than 5' beyond the tank cavity sidewalls and end; and to no more than 2' below the tank cavity bottom depth. The extent of soil requiring removal was determined by the digging of test pits to confirm uncontaminated conditions. Soils in the test pits were visually examined and were screened with a PID field instrument for evidence of fuel contamination. None was found.
