CALL BEFORE YOU DIG

- It is the law to call before you dig.
- ► It is **FREE**
- Call 811 or 1-800-362-2764 or e-dig online request for homeowners
- Call at least 48 hours prior to digging but not more than 10 days.
- The person actually digging needs to call OUPS to get a ticket number that being the home owner or the contractor.
- Record the ticket number if the utilities were mis-located and you hit one you are not responsible for it.

Examples When to Call

- Landscaping
- Digging holes for fence posts or a mailbox
- Anchoring supports for decks and swing sets
- Planting trees
- Removing tree roots
- Driving landscape stakes into the ground
- Installing a retaining wall

Follow These Steps for Safe Digging

- Call OUPS, 811 or 1-800-362-2764 or go online at e-dig
- Have the following information handy when you call
 - County, City, or Township
 - Digging location (street address and nearest cross street)
 - Type and extent of work (front/rear/both sides of property)
 - Digging start date and time
- Outline the area you plan to dig with white paint or flags
- Wait until utilities are marked before digging
- Once marked allow 18-inchs of tolerance from marked utilities
- Do not remove flags until job completed
- Also call Producers Underground Protection Service at 800-925-0988

Utility Color Codes

Red Electric power lines

- Yellow Gas, Oil, Steam, petroleum or gaseous materials
- Orange Communication, Alarm or signal lines
- ► Blue Potable Water
- Purple Reclaimed Water
- Green Sewers and Drain lines
- Pink Temporary survey markers
- White Proposed excavating
- If you hit a line leave the area and call 911 immediately.

RISK OF NOT CALLING

- Costly property or environmental damage
- Explosion or fire on your property
- Power or utilities services interruptions
- Legal problems
- ► Injury or DEATH
