Drum Management Overview

- Drum staging area is within the secured wet storage area
- Drums arrive secured 3 per pallet
- Drums are inspected to ensure structural integrity and clean exterior
- Each load of drums is certified to be free of explosives
- Each drum has a unique identification number, is inventoried and appropriately labeled
- Weekly inspections of staging area and drums
- Drum storage <90 days
- As soon as 70 drums are received, they are transported to the disposal facility
- Waste disposal is via thermal destruction
- To date there have been no safety incidents or accidents
- Veolia Environmental Solutions- Site visit by the US Army Corps of Engineers, reviewed the receiving & processing of materials in compliance with permit requirements.

Emergency Response Coordination – Transport Phase

- Triad Transport is monitored 24 hours by GPS tracking
- Emergency Response contractors are identified along entire haul route
 - Driver would notify dispatch who in turn notifies local police and fire departments
 - Following notification of police Triad would notify a facility Emergency Coordinator
 - Facility Operation Manager Safety Director
